- Sir Ronald Crawford Ferguson – leucogranite.
- Corin Doulton Hartland-Swann – black slate.
- Percival Andre Pickering – marble.
- Charles Babbage – grey granite.
- Monument next to the Soyer Memorial, inscription illegible – coarse calcarenite probably Clipsham Rag.
- John Lewis Bonhote Mausoleum – Cornish small megacrystic granite.
- Brunel Family grave marker – White Carrara Sicilian marble.
- Sir William Casement – Portland Stone & artificial stone.
- Charles & Henrietta Berwick Curtis – Bessbrook Granite.
- Hugh Falconer – leucogranite.
- John Gibson – Portland Basebed, Mansfield Red (or other red sandstone?), Peterhead Granite plinth.
- George Bellas Greenough Chest Tomb (Greenough is buried in the Catacombs) – Peterhead Granite.
- Morison Family Mausoleum – Portland Stone.
- William Mulready – Pulhamite.
- General Perry and Sir Patrick O'Brien (both husbands of Ida O'Brien) – Red Cheshire sandstone, Pennant sandstone, columns of grey granite porphyry.
- Millard Perring – Carrara Marble.
- Soyer Family Memorial – Carrara Marble, Portland Stone.
- John Thompson – Carrara Marble, Portland Stone.
- Wilson Family Chest Tomb – Cambrian Welsh Slate.
